

Agenda for Board Meeting for September 8, 2015

1. BOARD MINUTES APPROVED– August 11, 2015
Present at the meeting were Council members Barbara Scott, Jack Jones, and Zach Bowers and Clerk-Treasurer Martha Louk
2. GUESTS – Jim Cromwell, Rick Miles, Sheriff Stockton, Amanda Mahoy, Troy Elles, Kayla Mahoy, Holly Cook, and Debbie Sillery. Troy Elles (UMAC) gave a report on the Water and Wastewater plants. Debbie Sillery asked about zoning.
3. 2016 BUDGET – The first reading of the 2016 Budget was unanimously passed.
4. KEN SMITH – Ken gave the preliminary report on the smoke testing and the final report should be complete in a week. The zoning map will be complete in approximately a week.
5. STEVE EGLY – Steve Egly gave a quote to put all Ordinances on a CD for \$6200. Council members unanimously passed the quote.
6. BUILDING PERMITS – Jean Perkins building permit was unanimously approved.
7. TREE ESTIMATES – The tree estimate for 210 E Forest Home Street was tabled until next meeting.
8. TOWN MARSHAL MIKE MAHOY – Town Marshal Mike Mahoy stated that there was a conference on October 3rd and that he would like to attend and take Reserves Levi McCloud and Michael Parks. Mike also had an estimate for a new light bar for the Explorer for \$750. Both requests were unanimously approved.
9. TOWN EMPLOYEES – Jason Woodall had estimates for sidewalks and Council members unanimously approved Joe Spiker Excavating in the amount of \$10671.50. Jason also had quotes for a new zero turn mower and skid steer. Council members unanimously approved the quote from Plainfield Equipment in the amount of \$28,000.

Zach Bowers stated that the next Plan Commission meeting would be on September 2nd and 6:30. Jack Jones wants to get UMAC started on Frank Waldon's yard.

MEETING ADJOURNED – Council member Barbara Scott made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Zach Bowers seconded the motion.


