

## Board Meeting minutes for August 4, 2014


1. BOARD MINUTES APPROVED– July 8, 2014  
Present at the meeting were Council members Barbara Scott, Jackie Jones, and Zach Bowers and Clerk-Treasurer Martha Louk.
2. GUESTS – Joe Buser and Jim Bryant. Joe Buser asked to block off Railroad Street on October 4, 2014 from Indiana Street to Meridian Street starting at 6 a.m. for the Rib and Blues Festival. The festival will be from 4 p.m. to 11 p.m... Council members approved the request. Jim Bryant was here to let Council members know that they were cleaning up Ruby Bell's property.
3. PROPERTY CLEAN UPS - Council members awarded Charlie Boller his bid of \$1250 to clean up 302 E Columbia St... Council members would like to have another property clean up letter sent to the owner of 207 N. Meridian St. and 208 N West St...
4. SOUTH INDIANA ST BIDS – Three bids were submitted to mill and repave S. Indiana St. The bids were from Triangle Asphalt \$82,200, Wabash Valley Asphalt \$82,800, and City Wide Paving \$121,620. Zach Bowers made a motion to accept Triangle Asphalts bid and Barbara Scott seconded the motion.
5. BUILDING PERMIT – The building permit for 102 N Meridian St was approved with a motion made by Zach Bowers and seconded by Barbara Scott.
6. LYKINS – Lykins pay application was approved with a motion from Zach Bowers and seconded by Barbara Scott.
7. TREE REMOVAL ESTIMATES – Ora Smith submitted two bids for tree removals. The first one was for two maple trees located at S. Main St. and Grove St. in the amount of \$500 the second bid was for a tree located at 11 N. Meridian St. in the amount of \$500. The bids were unanimously approved by Council members.
8. TOWN MARSHAL MIKE MAHOY- Nothing to report
9. TOWN EMPLOYEES – Jason Woodall was given an hourly raise of \$1.50 for his Gas certification unanimously by Council members. Greg Poole asked to purchase a 1993 Chevy truck to replace the 1994 Ford F-350. The 1993 Chevy would cost \$3500 and permission to scrap the Ford. Council members unanimously approved the purchase of the 1993 Chevy and to scrap the 1994 Ford. Greg also stated that the John Deere tractor needed \$8500 worth of repairs. The tractor repairs were tabled until the September meeting.


In other business Council members offered Seth Campbell the Waste Water operator position at \$14.50 an hour and he accepted and would start working for the Town on August 18, 2014. Council members approved Kayla Mahoy, Tammy Folck, and Megan Rentfro for the Park Advisory Board. Council members want Officer Mike Mahoy to deliver an Ordinance ticket to Shirley Vance to clean up her property and give her 30 days.
