


## Board Meeting minutes for July 8, 2014


1. BOARD MINUTES APPROVED– June 2, 2014  
Present at the meeting were Council members Barbara Scott, Jack Jones, and J. Zachary Bowers, Town Attorney David Peebles, and Clerk-Treasurer Martha Louk
2. GUESTS – Troy Ellis, Brian Lathrop, Jason King, Amanda Mahoy, Kayla Mahoy, Steve Keck, Bob Keck, Jason Halcomb, Jim Cromwell, Tammy Folck, and Chuck McElwee. Tammy Folck stated that the new concrete for the shelter house will be done in August and asked Council members if ceiling fans be put up in the shelter house. Council members said no to ceiling fans. Bob and Steve Keck were asking what the time frame was to work on 405 E Washington St... Council members gave the Keck's 90 days. Barbara Scott made the motion Zach Bowers seconded the motion and Jack Jones abstained. Chuck McElwee from the Putnam County Animal Advisory Board was asking if the Town was going to contribute like surrounding communities. Clerk-Treasurer Martha Louk stated that we had the funds donated and that we were waiting on a contract that Lisa Mock was supposed to be working on. Jason King just wanted to submit his resume.

5. ORDINANCE 5-2014 – Ordinance 5-2014 did not pass.
6. LYKINS – Payment application for Lykins was unanimously passed
7. RATE STUDY – Clerk Treasurer Martha Louk asked Council members to have Pat Callahan do rate studies on the Water and Wastewater Utilities. Barbara Scott and Zachary Bowers approved the request.
8. BUILDING PERMIT – Ed Culley's building permit was unanimously approved and Allan Plunket's building permit was unanimously approved.
9. TOWN MARSHAL MIKE MAHOY – Town Marshal Mike Mahoy asked permission to get the snow cone machine again for National Night Out. Council members approved the request.
10. TOWN EMPLOYEES – Greg Poole stated that Lykins had finished the pressure testing and were doing water samples and then would be starting to install service lines.
11. K-9 Toby – Toby was sworn in.


