


Board Meeting Minutes for April 10, 2012

1. BOARD MINUTES APPROVED– March 13, 2012 meeting
Present at the meeting were Council members Jack Jones and Zach Bowers, Town Attorney David Peebles, and Clerk-Treasurer Martha Louk
2. GUESTS – Darla Stuart, Ed Hammond, Louis Richards, and Grant from the Banner Graphic
Darla Stuart and her realtor Ed Hammond asked Council members that if she sold her house if the new property owner wants to have horses could they since currently there are horses on the property. Council members told her not since the Town Ordinance states no horses. Darla asked Council members if they would change the Ordinance and they said no.
Louis Richards asked Council members if they had or were going to write an Ordinance on Fireworks. Town Attorney David Peebles stated that the State has a law in place already but the Town could send out letters to these individuals who did set off the fireworks last year explaining how they could be given a State Statute ticket and have other fines. Council members unanimously approved for Town Attorney to send out letters to the residents whom set off fireworks last year.
3. USDA – Project Budget formed signed by Jack Jones
4. ORDINANCE 2-2012 – Ordinance repealing Ordinances regulating firearms within the Town of Roachdale. Unanimously approved by Council members.
5. ORDINANCE 3-2012 – Ordinance authorizing preapproved payment of certain claims. Unanimously approved by Council members.
6. TOWN EMPLOYEES – Clint Anglin has two pieces of equipment from HACH that he would like to have approval for a contract maintenance agreement in the amount of \$819.00. Council members unanimously approved. Greg Poole asked Council members to sign an agreement with USDI stating their monthly retainer fee would now be \$175.00 instead of \$150.00. Council members unanimously approved this. Greg Poole also asked Council members to let them hire Jeff Combs to mow again this summer @ \$10 an hour for 20 hours a week. Council members unanimously approved.
7. TOWN MARSHAL – Mike Mahoy stated that Triple T in Bainbridge donated their time to fix the hood on the Charger. Mike also told Council members that he would be attending a class on April 30th in Plainfield on Drug Stops.

Zach Bowers went over the current Ordinance on Trash Burning and what Mike Poole had given him for suggestions for changing the Ordinance. Zach also asked about what the status was on the resident that stole water from the Town and asked someone to check with Hendricks County Shelter about taking stray dogs.


